“MOVING WALL”

Meadowbrook Park, across from Hamden Government Center at 2750 Dixwell Ave.

The Moving Wall is a ½ scale replica of the Vietnam Memorial located in Washington D.C. and brings to Hamden the names of 58,283 Americans who died in the Vietnam War. This is both a personal and community event for visitors to learn and reflect on what this memorial has come to mean to every citizen. Volunteers will be available to help find the name of a loved one on the panels.

Opening Ceremonies start Thursday, June 14th at 7:00 PM and the Moving Wall will be available for viewing 24 hours at day until Monday morning, June 18. Follow signs for off-street parking at Hamden Center with after hours parking at Hamden Government Center and Hamden Middle School. Handicapped parking is in the Miller Memorial Library lot.
