Tax Counseling for the Elderly, a FREE program available at the Miller Senior Center provides Federal and Connecticut income tax preparation assistance for low and middle-income taxpayers, with special attention to those 60 and older. **To schedule an appointment** with a certified Tax-Aide counselor or to obtain information, call the Miller Senior Center (287-2547).

At a tax counseling session the taxpayer is requested to have:

- Social Security number and personal identification.
- All 2009 income reports that have been received:
- SSA-1099 forms (Social Security benefits paid).
- All 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-R, 1099-B, 1099-Misc, etc.).
- W-2 forms from each employer.
- Unemployment compensation forms.
- All forms that indicate Federal and/or CT income taxes were paid for 2009.
- Original cost of assets sold during 2009.
