When requesting a ride, leave **ONLY** your name and phone number and your call will be returned. No appointments are scheduled more than one week in advance.

**RULES FOR PASSENGERS**

1. **Donations:** Suggested donation for all rides is 50 cents one way or \$1 round trip. Nutrition rides are 25 cents one way and 50 cents round trip.  
**Eligibility:** Participants must be Hamden residents and 60 years of age or older.
2. Please be ready for the bus one hour prior to appointment time. Driver will assist and escort from the door to the vehicle and back. If you live in an apartment please be down in the lobby waiting.
3. In the event of illness or change in plans, telephone the mini-bus dispatcher well in advance of scheduled pick-up times so that the Dispatcher may inform the bus drivers.
4. All passengers must be seated and **seat belts fastened** when the Mini-Bus is in operation.
5. No smoking is permitted on bus.
6. As a safety measure, conversation with the drivers is **not allowed** when bus is in motion.
7. Arguing or use of abusive language will not be tolerated.
8. No consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed on bus. Transportation will not be provided for an intoxicated person.
9. The Mini-Bus door is to be opened by the driver only; passengers are to remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
10. Passengers may **not** request the driver to make changes in bus routes or stops that have been established by the dispatcher.
11. No unauthorized persons will be allowed to ride the mini-bus. All names must appear on the driver's schedule.
12. In fairness to everyone, please do not ask the dispatchers or the drivers to make exceptions to these rules.
