Mission Statement: The Hamden Public Library is the community hub for knowledge, culture, imagination and learning acting as an anchor of the Town, a centering place for developing a community and providing the auxiliary virtual services to those at home. The Library Board oversees the Town's library system that includes the Miller Memorial Central Library and two branches: the Whitneyville Branch and the Louise A. Brundage Community Branch Library.

Goals for the Future: The Library Board's goals for 2006 include approving a five-year strategic plan which would in effect continue to maximize the full potential of the Horizon system to include time/ print management on the public PC's and implement the self-checkout station at Miller, install a wireless service at Miller and the branches, and complete the renovation of the Miller Children's department Early Readers section.
