Hamden Arts, Recreation & Culture Department Offers Exciting New Bus Trips

The Hamden Arts, Recreation and Culture Department is offering some exciting bus trips for 2016 including: food tours, festivals, flower shows, baseball games and more! All fees include round-trip motor coach transportation. Trips depart from the commuter parking lot on Devine Street in North Haven (near Hamden Town line).

The following trips are scheduled:

- Philadelphia Flower Show on March 5; this year's theme is "National Parks"; includes leisure time for lunch and shopping at the Reading Terminal Market; \$109/person
- Boston Flower & Garden Show on March 19; this year's theme is "Nurtured by Nature"; includes leisure time at Quincy Market, Newbury Street, Copley Place and Haymarket Square; \$85/person
- Maple Sugaring in the Berkshires on March 19; visit Ioka Valley Farm's Sugar House and enjoy a pancake lunch in the "Calf-A" and admission to the Norman Rockwell Museum; \$97/person
- NYC Food & Market Tour on either March 19 or May 14; sample the neighborhood of Arthur Avenue, China Town, Little Italy, Eataty, Gotham West Market; \$73/person (food is not included)
- Bronx Zoo on April 9; Includes the "Total Experience Ticket" (TEX) for the special exhibits and attractions like Congo Gorilla Forest, Butterfly Zone, Bengali Express Monorail; \$93/adult, \$89 for children 3-12
- 9/11 Museum, 9/11 Memorial & One World Observatory Tour on April 16; \$125/person
- Hyde Park on April 23; visit the home of Franklin D. Roosevelt, the Vanderbilt

Mansion and lunch at the Eveready Diner (as seen on the Food Network); meal choices are baked Virginia Ham, roast turkey, meat loaf, crusted chicken mista salad; \$109/person

- Intrepid & Enterprise on April 30; visit the Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum, Space Shuttle Pavilion and enjoy an included light lunch (sandwich). Day concludes at Times Square; \$109/person
- United States Military Academy at West Point on April 30; Tour includes West Point Parade Review and lunch at the Thayer Hotel; Security requires that everyone 16 years and older bring a photo ID; \$119/person
- NY Yankees Baseball in the Audi Suites at Yankee Stadium on May 7 vs Boston for \$239/person; on July 17 vs Boston for \$239/person or July 23 vs San Francisco for \$229/person
- Boston Red Sox Baseball at Fenway Park in grandstand seating section 7 on May 1 vs NY Yankees for \$139/person or on May 14 vs Houston for \$105/person
- Lobster Bake in Gloucester & Rockport on June 11; dine at the famous Gloucester House renowned for its lobster dishes (menu includes lobster, chicken or steak, chowder, corn potato); visit the Fisherman's Statue and enjoy leisure time in Rockport at Bearskin Neck; \$127/person
