- A newsstand/coffee shop in Govt. Center
- Make a list of Hamden's scenic roads and farm stands
- TOD with a brew pub and light rail for a newly created downtown
- A system of early care and education (birth through five) that is of high quality and affordable/accessible.
- A new community center in southern Hamden that can be a hub of activity for all folks from Hamden, particularly our young people and elderly... including after school, evening and weekend hours. This building would house a pool, gymnasium, theater, boxing, arts, study rooms, comfortable, non-institutional rooms for leisure, outdoor recreation, etc.
- Clean and tidy sidewalks and open areas-particularly in southern Hamden
- A Public playground in northern Hamden
- A more "walker, biker, driver friendly" environment, particularly in southern Hamden, near the Keefe Community Center
- Additional hours at the Whitneyville branch library
- Public art---lots of it---decorative, but also some that is thought provoking and utilitarian (i.e. seating, bus stops, lighting, signage, etc.)
- Police stationed (not just driving) throughout the community in different neighborhoods, this may require additional police
- Additional quality, after school programming that is affordable for working parents and of course, to enrich the lives of our young people
