School Age Child Care Program (K – 6)

Monday - Friday 3:00 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

School vacations: 8:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

OEC State of Connecticut Department of Public Health licensed program. Field trips, enrichment activities, homework help, music, arts and crafts. Transportation from area schools & healthy daily snacks offered. Sliding Fee Scale. Hamden residents only.

Let's Move Kids Club

A 2.5 hour program for students in Grades 1-3, teaches the importance of exercise and good nutrition in a fun, comfortable and non-judgmental environment. This program is offered throughout the year at various locations including the public elementary schools. Please call for additional information.

Summer Youth Employment (ages 14-21)

5-7 weeks. Approximately 15-25 hours per week. Economically disadvantaged youth or youth that receive special education services are eligible for summer jobs in municipal, non-profit and for-profit entities in Hamden. Slots are limited according to available funding. Youth earn minimum wage. Hamden residents only.

Red Cross Certified

Babysitting Training (ages 11-15)

Year round (schedule, location to be announced- please call for additional information). Teaches skills in leadership, basic care, safety, and safe play, as well as first aid. This is a two day training. (includes Babysitter's Training Handbook and certificate).

Volunteer Program

Placements vary according to needs in the community and interests of the volunteer. Hamden residents only or must volunteer in the town of Hamden. Ages 12-adult.

Prevention Fairs

Substance Abuse Educational Fairs offered for 6th grade students at all elementary schools. Interactive stations facilitated by high school students. Provides students with information on self-esteem, bullying, drugs, alcohol and tobacco and to educate and empower students to resist negative peer pressure and to stay drug free.

Resource Library and Referrals

Drug and alcohol prevention, parent education, violence prevention and more. Available year round.

School Supplies Closet

Free for Hamden youth in need (Preschool – College). Available year round.

Health, Wellness and Safety events and programs, Gender based programs, Lights on After-School, National Night Out, SoHa Kid Fest, Substance Abuse Prevention.
