



Summer Youth Employment 2016

In order to qualify for this program, you must be a Hamden resident, qualify to receive free or reduced lunch and/or receive special education services. Participants must currently be full time high school students 14-21 years of age.

The week of April 25-April 29th, Hamden High School and HCLC will have summer youth employment applications available in the School Guidance office. *A limited number of applications are available.*

If you are a Hamden resident and attend a school outside of Hamden, you may pick up an application at the Youth Services' office on 11 Pine Street (Keefe Community Center) between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Applications will be accepted and interviews will take place at The Keefe Community Center (11 Pine Street) on Wednesday, May 11th from 2:30-5:30 p.m. and Thursday, May 12th from 12:30-5:30. Please sign in with a Youth Services' employee on the first floor. You will be instructed to wait for your interview in the lounge or gym, based on availability. Interviews will take place on a first come, first serve basis.

Please read this document carefully (at the top). If you do not qualify, please do not take an application, as it can be used for someone that does qualify. If you are unsure, please ask Susan Rubino, Coordinator or Beth Chiarillo, Outreach Counselor, and we will be happy to help you.

Applications must be completed and signed, including copies of all required documentation*. Please arrive appropriately dressed.
