

THE HISTORIC PROPERTIES COMMISSION

Amended Minutes: The Historic Properties Commission Town of Hamden held a regular meeting on Wednesday, April 20, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the Parks and Recreation Dept., Hamden Government Center, 2750 Dixwell Avenue. The following issues were discussed:

CALL TO ORDER—Chairman Levine called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Approval of Minutes - Chairman Levine motioned to approve the minutes of the meeting of March 16, 2011. Dr. Doheny motioned to approve the minutes with the following corrections. On page one Mr. Baker and M. Ioime were noted as both present and absent. *They were both absent.* On page one the last line the sentence should read “*Commission to comment on the tower*”. The motioned is seconded by Ms. Highkin. ***The motion carried unanimously.***

PUBLIC HEARING – Not at this time.

PUBLIC SESSION – Nothing at this time.

CHAIR REPORT/CORRESPONDENCE – Nothing at this time.

Unfinished Business

- a. Memorial Town Hall – Mr. Gorman noted the project is moving along and the police department is expected to move in the end of June. At this time a traffic study is being done on the parking. The Commission would like to see a sketch of the planned landscaping.
- b. Jepp’s Brook Millsite – Mr. Gorman provided a copy of the brochure. There were a couple of questions regarding the statement on the back and Mr. Gorman and Mr. Levine were going to speak with the printer about it.
- c. Hamden Cemeteries follow up from Mr. Ioime – Mr. Ioime advised the Commission that at this time he has no additional information but is still working on this project.
- d. Other Business – Mr. Gorman provided a copy the Archeological Survey on Lock 14. He advised the members that the other copies needed have been given to the necessary parties. Chairman Levine inquired if there was enough information in the survey to do a brochure on Lock 14 and Mr. Gorman and Chairman Levine will review and get back to the Commission on a possible brochure. Chairman Levine advised the members that he, Dr. Doheny, Mr. Minkema

and Mr. Baker attended the Planning and Zoning meeting of April 12, 2011. Mr. Minkema had submitted the application for the Proposed Historic District-Ivesville. It was noted by P&Z that the application omitted six properties. Also the study submitted was incorrect. A study dated October 2, 2009 was submitted and it should have been the one dated February 17, 2011. The P&Z has no objections to the formation of the Ivesville Historic District, however they made recommendations. The P&Z would like the following 1) the properly dated study be provided in two weeks. The corrections discussed regarding the map made as well and that all be made available for review within a week. After a lengthy discussion Dr. Doheny motioned to add 8 Broadway to the application as recommended by the P&Z, seconded by Ms. Highkin. ***The motion carried unanimously.***

New Business – Nothing at this time.

Adjournment – At 8:00 Ms. Highkin motioned to adjourn, seconded by Dr. Doheny. ***The motion carried unanimously.***
