- c. Hamden Cemeteries – Mr. Ioime spoke with Mr. Aranci and it appears nothing will be done at this time. Mr. Ioime will look at other possible avenues for help.
- d. Ivesville District – Chairman Levine is waiting to speak with Mr. Minkema and hopefully will have information for the May 2013 meeting.
- e. Other Business – Mr. Gorman advised the Commission that the Town has applied for a grant to help with the roof for the Masselli Barn. Some other work needs to be done along with the roof are windows and some siding, trimming of the trees and removal of some items around the Barn. Also, Urban Minors have items stored in the Barn that need to be removed. An inspection shows the Barn is sound. An updated survey needs to be done as soon as possible.
Earth Day will be held, Saturday, April 20. 2013 and Ms. Highkin and Mr. Murphy have volunteered to help at the table.
No news on the Saw Mill.
