Also he is finalizing the acquisition new firearms also from Stimulus money.
- b. Budget Review – Chief Wydra advised the Commission he is waiting to meet with the Mayor on the budget proposed for 2010- 2011, the copy of same included in the packet. He is working with the current budget 2009-2010 but as always there will be OT that will need to be covered and he will be able to do this.
