4 OPEN DISCUSSION - Nothing at this time.

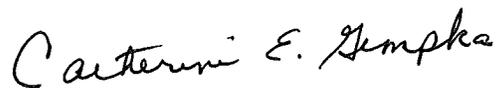
5 EXECUTIVE SESSION – Not at this time.
