Dear Sirs,

I am writing due to my concern over a curve near my house on 215 West Woods Road. There are many curves on this road but this turn does not enable a driver to see what is ahead. Since this road is often used as a cut through for traffic traveling between Shepard Avenue and Whitney Avenue, cars usually drive rather fast on this road. There have been police cars to catch people speeding, which have helped for a while, but of course short time later cars are speeding again.

For years I have been extra careful when pulling into my driveway when traveling towards Whitney Avenue. I check to see if any cars are behind me and put on my signal light way ahead of time in case I have to wait to pull into my driveway due to oncoming cars. I have to be careful because a car cannot see me when it is coming around the corner.

I also have been concerned because at times my children have been picked up and dropped off from the school bus on the opposite side of the road. Since a car cannot see the bus when coming down the road towards Whitney, a driver could hit the bus or swerve to avoid it and possibly hit one of my children.

The other day I was talking to a neighbor who lives on the other side of the street and has to cross the road every day to get her mail. She mentioned that she was almost hit by a car one day. The driver yelled at her that she was going to get killed one day if she didn't watch out. As we finished talking and she started crossing the road toward her house, a car came down the street. Fortunately, it stopped in time, but I became very concerned about her having to cross the street every day. There is no way that she can see cars coming around the corner or the drivers seeing her crossing. A car coming down the road too quickly is a serious and dangerous situation.

I would appreciate the Traffic Commission's involvement to make this section of West Woods Road safe for both drivers and residents. Thank you.
