

## **HAMDEN POLICE CHIEF COMMUNITY INPUT AND TRANSPARENCY COMMITTEE**

**June 12, 2019**

Meeting called to order at 6:15 pm by Chairman Keith King. Members in attendance were Keith King, Anthony Harper, Scott Jackson, Elana Williams Rountree, and Toni Foreman.

Mr. King reported on the establishment of an email address, town website, and facebook presence. He indicated that responses to the email may help provide guidance on issues that may arise at the public hearings. Mr. Jackson offered to inform the Chair of the Police Commission and investigate the monitoring of the email account prior to the June 19 meeting, which will be posted from 6pm to 7:30 pm. Mr. King will arrange a setup that includes tables and chairs; Ms. Rountree Williams displayed a potential two-color post note system through which participants can write their comments. The committee maintained the posture that flexibility would be critical to success.

The committee reviewed the proposed poster prepared by the Mayor's Office advertising the public sessions.

The panel discussed mechanics of the public meeting.

Mr. Jackson indicated that he had spoken to the Town Attorney and POST regarding their correspondence, and there is consensus that the correspondence conforms to Connecticut General Statutes.
