**1. Amendment to §95.11 (B) of the Code of Ordinances**

-- Moved by Ms. Sweet, seconded by Mr. Webber. DISCUSSION: Ms. Gallagher asked about the BOE> Mr. Garce said they're not issuing permits on BOE property. Ms. Irvin asked about other Towns that have this, point of liability and how we control patrons from bringing their own. Mr. Grace said many Towns already allow for the sale of alcohol and that it's common. He said liability is tied to the vendor's liquor license. A vote was taken and the item passed unanimously.
