PUBLIC HEARING: There was 1 speaker

The following items were addressed:

1. Refund of Property Taxes collected prior to July 1, 2020 – (4) totaling \$3,555.51

-- Moved by Ms. Schomaker, seconded by Ms. Dolan and approved unanimously.

**2. Refund of Property Taxes collected between to July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021
– (2) totaling \$222.27**

-- Moved by Ms. Dolan, seconded by Ms. Wetmore and approved unanimously.

**3. Refund of Motor Vehicle Taxes collected between July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021 –
(25) totaling \$7,690.45**

-- Moved by Mr. Cesare, seconded by Ms. Wetmore and approved unanimously.

**4. Reappointment of Kurt Bauknecht to the Board of Assessment Appeals for a term to expire
January 31, 2024**
