A meeting of the Municipal Planning & Properties Committee was held on Monday, July 18, 2022 electronically via ZOOM due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The meeting was called to order at 9:52 PM by Abdul Osmanu, Chair.

The following items were addressed:

1. Order authorizing the Mayor to apply for, accept and expend funding up to \$341,000 in State of Connecticut Local Capital Improvement Program (LoCip) Funds for Pavement Repair and Maintenance Program

-- Moved by Mr. Osmanu, seconded by Mr. Webber. DISCUSSION: Mr. White explained the item. Mr. Farmer said he appreciates getting this list. Mr. Stevens asked will this be public at some point. Mr. White said yes, once we finalize all data. A vote was taken and the item passed unanimously.

2. Order authorizing the Mayor to apply for, accept and expend funding up to \$400,000 in State of Connecticut Local Capital Improvement Program (LoCip) funds for Sidewalk Repairs and Improvements

-- Moved by Mr. Osmanu, seconded by Mr. Webber and approved unanimously.

Mr. Osmanu moved a motion to add the following item to his committee. Mr. Stevens seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

3. Resolution authorizing the Town of Hamden to file an application for financial assistance from the Connecticut Department of Economic & Community Development (DECD) and if offered accept and expend funds Community Investment Fund 2030 (Newhall Area Drainage System Project \$8,500.000)

-- Moved by Mr. Osmanu, seconded by Mr. O'Brien DISCUSSION: Mr. White explained the areas of flooding and reasons why – small pipes, old inlets, etc. A vote was taken and the item passed unanimously.
