A meeting of the Public Works & Parks Committee was held on Monday, November 8, 2021, electronically via Zoom due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. The meeting was called to order at 8:23 P.M. by the Vice-Chair, Kristen Zaehringer.

**MEMBERS ABSENT:** Jeron Alston, Chair; Kristin Dolan; Betty Wetmore;

**PUBLIC INPUT:** None

The following items were addressed:

1. Appointment of Oscar Bolanos to the Solid Waste & Recycling Commission for a term to expire July 1, 2023

-- Moved by Mr. Webber, seconded by Ms. Rowe-Lewis and approved unanimously.

2. Order approving a Municipal Waste Disposal Services Agreement between the Town of Hamden and Murphy Road Recycling, LLC

-- Moved by Mr. Webber, seconded by Ms. Rowe-Lewis. DISCUSSION: Assistant Town Attorney Brendan Sharkey gave an overview of this agreement saying they need to execute to continue trash pick-up. He said in April of 2020 a facility closed and forced us to seek another location to dispose of curbside trash. Murphy Road stepped up and made their facility available to us and since last April they've allowed it but not by contract. He said this is the sister company of All American Waste and is a 3 year contract.

A vote was taken and the item passed unanimously.

3. Order approving first amendment to Collection Agreement between the Town of Hamden and All American Waste, LLC

-- Moved by Ms. Rowe-Lewis, seconded by Mr. Webber. DISCUSSION: Assistant Town Attorney Brendan Sharkey gave an overview of this and said there is no cost to the Town. He said because of the above we'll be in violation of curbside with All American Waste where there is a provision to limit travel distance to 15 road miles and the facility is in excess of 15 miles so to make sure it's all in sync this amendment is needed.

A vote was taken and the item passed unanimously.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:38 P.M.
